A1	Broken Access Control Improperly enforced access restrictions allow attackers to bypass authentication and access unauthorized data or functions.		0
A2	Cryptographic Failures Weak encryption or improper handling of sensitive data (e.g., passwords, credit card details) can lead to data leaks.		0
A3	Injection Malicious input (e.g., SQL, NoSQL, OS command injection) is improperly handled, allowing attackers to manipulate databases or execute unintended commands.		0
A4	Insecure Design Poor application design choices, such as missing security controls, increase vulnerability risks.		0
A5	Security Misconfiguration Default settings, exposed error messages, or unnecessary services can create security gaps.		0
A6	Vulnerable and Outdated Components Using outdated software, libraries, or frameworks with known vulnerabilities can lead to exploits.		0
A7	Identification and Authentication Failures Weak authentication mechanisms, such as poor password policies or missing multi-factor authentication (MFA), can lead to unauthorized access.		0
A8	Software and Data Integrity Failures Untrusted or malicious updates, dependencies, or CI/CD pipelines can lead to compromised systems.		0
